The school got affiliation from Cambridge University and we are starting a new venture keeping our faith in your whole hearted support and good wishes. The school wants to provide international standard education (Examination) along with CBSE so that our students can be prepared to face the challenges of the fast changing life and educational requirements.

The **IGCSE** (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) is an internationally recognized qualification for school students, typically in the 15-16 age groups. It is conducted at the class 9-10 level similar to the class 10 examinations of CBSE and ICSE. IGCSE, formed in 1988, is a comprehensive two years programme, spread over class 9 and 10, and leads to the final examinations offered every year in May and November.

A wide range of international schools in India offer high quality International General Certificate of Secondary Education programs to students, IGCSE is one of the most sought after and recognized qualifications in the world.

Both Cambridge IGCSE and O Level lead directly to A Levels, the 'gold standard' pre-university qualification, *recognised worldwide*. Every year tens of thousands of Cambridge students get the A Level grades they need to go to university, where they arrive well prepared for their degree course-some even earning advanced credit for their qualifications.
